RULES: The Race will be governed by:

- 1. The Racing Rules of Sailing (2017-2020)
- 2. This Notice of Race
- 3. Sailing Instructions (OHYC 2019)

ELIGIBILITY: Entrants are encouraged to have a valid PHRF Northwest Certificate. If a yacht does not have a current PHRF Certificate, a rating can be assigned by the R/C.

CLASSES: There will be two classes. A PHRF flying sails class and a non-flying "Windseeker" class. At race committee's discretion classes can be added or combined depending on number of boats participating.

COURSE: Saturday will consist of buoy races. Courses will be displayed on a reader board hung from the R/C Boat in accordance with OHYC Sailing Instructions 2019. The first race will start at 1200. No race will start after 1600. **Sunday** will consist of a long distance race. The race will start at 11:00. Course will start near "R2" buoy, then keep the Baby Island "G1" can to port. Race committee may assign an alternate course on Sunday at their discretion depending on the wind. The distance race will have a finish time limit of 1800.

ENTRY FEES: \$35 per boat. Registration is free for boats that registered and paid for the entire summer series with the OHYC.

MEALS: A catered dinner will be available Saturday night following racing for skippers, crew and guests. Dinner tickets wil be available for \$10 per person. Drinks will be available at a no host bar at OHYC.

SKIPPER'S MEETING: Skipper's meeting will be held at the head of the dock near the Oak Harbor Yacht Club at 10:30 a.m. Saturday October 5, 2019.

ENTRY FORMS AND SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Entry form and Sailing instructions will be available online and at the skippers meeting.

Before October 3: mail registration to the OHYC at 1301 Catalina Drive, Oak Harbor, WA, 98277.

After October 3: email your intention to participate and number of meals for Saturday night to the Sailfleet Captain, ohsailfleet@gmail.com. Bring registration and payment to the skippers meeting.

SCORING: The race will be scored using the Low Point System. Corrected times for Saturday will be calculated using time on time. There will be no throw outs. Sunday's distance race will be counted as two races in the overall scoring with results being calculated using both time on time AND time on distance.
